With the recent passing of Civil Justice Reform (CJR), the civil litigation landscape in Hong Kong has been fundamentally altered.

For some years to come there will still be cases before the court that have been started prior to the CJR, so this will be the last opportunity to buy bound volumes of pre-CJR HKWB.

Residual cases shall continue to be heard under the pre-CJR Rules for some time beyond the expected 2 April 2009 CJR implementation date. Therefore the pre-CJR HKWB volumes are an essential reference for any Hong Kong law library.
